SOWING HOPE IN QUEBEC'S EVANGELICAL DESERT

Despite being part of Canada, **Quebec remains one of the most spiritually under-reached regions in North America.** Fewer than **2% of the population identifies as evangelical Christian**, and for many, meaningful engagement with a local church is limited or absent. Yet even in this resistant environment, **God continues to open doors for the gospel.**



Since 2002, **TWR Canada has partnered with Aujourd'hui L'Espoir (Today's Hope)** to reach French-speaking Canadians through media outreach, including **television, FM radio broadcasting, digital platforms, and innovative ministry tools.** This partnership helps extend gospel witness across the province, especially as many local churches, often small and limited in resources, are **unable to sustain broad outreach efforts on their own.**

Aujourd'hui L'Espoir reaches people where they are—at home, on the move, online, and in their communities through biblical teaching shared via the television program **La Parole Vivante, RadioEspoir**, and a growing digital presence. Their ministry also includes the **Hope Line**, a toll-free resource that connects listeners to **prayer, guidance, helpful resources, and local churches** for those seeking to learn more about Jesus. **Even for those without reliable internet access, the message continues through creative tools designed to ensure no one is out of reach.**

God meets each of us where we are and gently calls us toward hope. Through the partnership of TWR Canada and Aujourd'hui L'Espoir, **the gospel continues to take root across Quebec—one broadcast at a time.**

A NEW CHAPTER OF HOPE IN CUBA

Across Cuba, believers continue to **worship, pray, and serve despite increasing hardship**. Frequent blackouts, limited resources, and economic strain affect daily life, yet **the gospel continues to bring strength and hope**. For more than **60 years**, **Cubans have heard the message of Christ through TWR broadcasts from Bonaire**, and today **TWR Canada partners with RTM Cuba to continue this vital work**.

RTM Cuba's ministry now extends beyond broadcasting through a **renewed ministry hub in Havana** supporting training, outreach, and production; **house-church networks** bringing worship and teaching into homes; and **digital tools such as WhatsApp messages, portable players, and radio programs** that reach people who may never attend church. Across cities, towns, and remote communities, **God's Word is being heard and lives are being transformed**.

This past fall, **Hurricane Melissa struck southeastern Cuba, causing widespread destruction** in already vulnerable areas. While RTM Cuba Director Moisés Pérez and his team remain safe in the north, many listeners live in the hardest-hit regions. Even so, **the team continues to serve faithfully**, offering encouragement, teaching, and practical support. **Thanks to generous donors, immediate relief and ongoing assistance have reached those affected!**

Building on this work, the team now connects with **more than 5,000 listeners** through in-person groups and online engagement, with **plans to reach 50,000**. Partnerships with pastors in each province are expanding discipleship opportunities, and new groups are forming using **Discipleship Essentials and Spanish Bibles delivered on radios and SD cards**. Testimonies continue to emerge as **people, learn, and grow together**.

WEEK 3 ROOTS OF GROWTH (CUBA)

RTM Cuba is bringing **the hope of Christ to families across the island** as they navigate hardship and **ongoing recovery from Hurricane Melissa**. In partnership with TWR Canada, the team reaches **cities and remote communities** through **radio broadcasts, house-church networks, and digital outreach**. Please keep the leaders, team, and communities they serve in your prayers, **trusting God to provide direction, resilience, and growth**. *"The Lord will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame."* — **Isaiah 58:11**

15+16 Pray for families still affected by Hurricane Melissa, especially those who have lost homes, livelihoods, and access to basic necessities. May they experience God's comfort, hope, and provision during this rebuilding season.

17 Father, please strengthen RTM Cuba Director Moisés, Kesia, Wilfredo, Parscey, and their families as they serve in the hardest-hit areas, providing practical support, encouragement, and the hope of Christ amid ongoing recovery.

18 Pray for Cuba's current hardships, including frequent blackouts, limited fuel, food shortages, and restricted access to the internet. May God bring change, sustain believers, and keep the flame of the gospel alive across the island.

19 Pray for the new listener groups forming across Cuba, that those gathering to study *Discipleship Essentials* and scripture on SD cards will grow in faith, encourage one another, and share the hope of Christ with their communities.

20+21 Pray for the team's partnerships with pastors in each province, that these connections would expand discipleship opportunities, strengthen the local church through partnerships with *The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary*, and guide RTM Cuba as they look ahead with anticipation.

FROM TOWERS TO TEACHING: CULTIVATING HEARTS ACROSS BOLIVIA

RTM Bolivia continues to share the hope of Christ across the country through strengthened infrastructure and ongoing discipleship programming. With the support of TWR Canada, recent efforts have expanded radio broadcast reach while ensuring trusted biblical content airs nationwide.

A key milestone was the completion of the Santiago FM 100.1 tower project in the Tucavaca Valley. As migration to Serranías de Santiago and Chochís increased, a nearby mountain limited the FM signal. RTM Bolivia addressed this by raising the Santiago tower by 40 metres, extending coverage to previously unreached listeners. The project concluded in December 2024, and in July 2025, RTM leaders celebrated the FM signal's reopening — an important step in reaching both urban and remote communities with biblical teaching and discipleship resources.

Alongside the tower project, RTM Bolivia's programming ministry continues to grow. Discipleship Essentials and Bible Stories Alive are broadcast in Spanish on more than 110 FM stations nationwide. Discipleship Essentials equips adults with foundational biblical teaching and reaches 75 outlets monthly, while Bible Stories Alive airs on 76 stations, sharing Bible stories and Christian values with children.

To reach areas without reliable broadcasts, RTM Bolivia distributes programs on CDs and USBs through courier services, buses, and personal delivery, while also visiting select stations to strengthen broadcast impact.

Through infrastructure improvements and ongoing program distribution, TWR Canada and RTM Bolivia are working together to ensure God's Word reaches hearts across Bolivia — nurturing faith, discipleship, and lasting spiritual growth.

WEEK 4 PRAISE FOR GOD'S HARVEST (BOLIVIA)

As RTM Bolivia celebrates the completion of the Santiago FM tower and continues to share biblical teaching across the country, we ask you to hold this growing ministry in prayer. Lift up the team, the broadcasters, and the many listeners now being reached through stronger signals and faithful programming. Pray that God would use every broadcast and relationship to draw hearts closer to Him, bringing growth, wisdom, and transformed lives. "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow." — 1 Corinthians 3:6-7

22+23 Praise God for the completed Santiago FM 100.1 tower expansion, and we pray that the strengthened signal would continue to reach communities in the Tucavaca Valley, including Serranías de Santiago and Chochís, bringing lasting hope and spiritual growth through the message of Christ.

24 Pray for the RTM Bolivia team as they share *Discipleship Essentials* and *Bible Stories Alive*, asking God to give them wisdom, discernment, and encouragement in every interaction and decision.

25 Pray for the programs themselves, that the biblical teaching in *Discipleship Essentials* and the stories shared through *Bible Stories Alive* would inspire faith, nurture spiritual growth, and cultivate lasting faith in individuals and families across Bolivia.

26 Pray for the radio stations broadcasting these programs, that visits and relationships with RTM Bolivia would strengthen partnerships, encourage local staff, and enhance the effectiveness of each broadcast in serving their communities.

27+28 Pray for the safe and timely delivery of CDs, USBs, and other program materials, especially to remote and hard-to-reach areas, so listeners everywhere can access God's Word and experience hope that continues to bear spiritual fruit.

BROADCASTING TRUTH: RMT PARAGUAY CONNECTS WITH YOUTH THROUGH PODCASTING

In today's world, **youth and young adults are constantly exposed to messages on social media that distort truth**, promoting ideas and values that often contradict biblical teaching. **RTM Paraguay is addressing this challenge with *Podcast Vital Code***, a 30-minute weekly program in both audio and video formats that tackles **real and relevant topics from a biblical perspective**.

With the support of TWR Canada, which covers production costs, RTM Paraguay has made **significant progress in both content and outreach**. Three episodes are recorded each month in the RTM studio, with one episode produced live in various locations. To date, **the team has produced 40 of 52 planned broadcasts, including 8 live programs that allow meaningful audience interaction**.

The podcast team recently completed the remodeling of the studio, recorded 25 episodes, and uploaded them to **YouTube and Spotify**, attracting new audiences and fostering engagement. **Live events, including the OPED Intercollegiate, brought together more than 200 young people** from several educational institutions, giving participants a space to **connect with biblical teaching and interact directly with the team**.

Podcast Vital Code has also **extended its reach beyond Paraguay**, with programs broadcast on **Radio Luz en la Oscuridad in Peru** and **Radio El Sonido de Vida in Bolivia**

Through TWR Canada's partnership and the generosity of Canadian donors, **Podcast Vital Code and RTM Paraguay are equipping a new generation to live faithfully** — providing a platform for discipleship and spiritual growth.

WEEK 5 PODCAST VITAL CODE (PARAGUAY)

As *Podcast Vital Code* continues to **engage youth and young adults across Paraguay**, we can bring the program before God in prayer, **trusting Him to guide, bless and multiply every effort**. 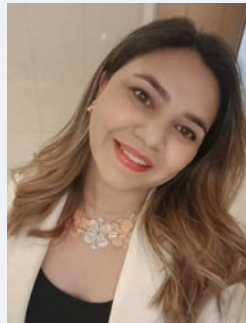

EQUIPPING WOMEN IN PARAGUAY THROUGH FAITH, MEDIA, & PRACTICAL TRAINING

Women of Hope Paraguay is actively reaching women in communities throughout the country, providing **spiritual encouragement alongside practical training** to help them thrive. With the support of TWR Canada, the ministry uses a **blend of radio broadcasts, printed and digital resources, and in-person gatherings to meet women where they are.**

From July through December 2025, the **Kuña Paraguai and Women of Hope programs** continued airing consistently in Spanish, **reaching women in 12 cities.** Each program addresses **practical topics for daily life**, shares **testimonies of transformation**, and applies biblical principles in ways that strengthen families and communities. Devotionals by **Dr. Carmen Laterza** are also shared widely through WhatsApp groups, offering **ongoing spiritual encouragement throughout the week.**

Prayer calendars remain a key tool for connection and growth.

Printed calendars in German are distributed to Mennonite colonies such as Neuland, Menno, Fernheim, Concordia, Volendam, and Friesland, where **women gather regularly to pray together for each month's requests.** Digital calendars, primarily in Spanish and some in German, are shared through WhatsApp networks, **helping women across diverse regions stay united in prayer.**

Monthly gatherings continue to bring **women from vulnerable neighbourhoods** together for workshops that **combine Bible study with skill-building**, supporting both personal well-being and family care. Through **leadership development, media production, and ongoing support, TWR Canada helps ensure Women of Hope Paraguay continues to grow** — equipping women with the **guidance, tools, and encouragement needed for spiritual and practical transformation.**

WEEK 6 PLANTING FAITH IN PARAGUAY (WOH)

TWR Canada partners with **Women of Hope** to bring **God's message of hope, encouragement, and practical support to women across Paraguay.** Through **radio programs, digital and printed prayer resources, and local gatherings**, this ministry is helping women **grow in faith and experience God's care firsthand.** We invite you to hold it in prayer, trusting God to sustain it and bring lasting fruit. **"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up." — Galatians 6:9**

5+6 Lord, draw women across Paraguay — in towns, cities, and communities — beyond cultural Christianity to truly know Jesus through *Women of Hope* programs in Guarani and Spanish.



7 Father, we lift up women in Paraguay facing violence and hopelessness in their homes and neighbourhoods. Surround them with Your protection, healing, and renewed hope and direction.

8 God, strengthen the national coordinator as she seeks to deepen the reach and impact of *Women of Hope* across Paraguay. Give her wisdom as she supports prayer groups and leads media outreach.

9 We thank You, Lord, for prayer calendars reaching Mennonite colonies, WhatsApp groups, and individual homes. Use them to encourage believers in Paraguay and deepen faithful, consistent prayer.

10 Pray that the *Women of Hope* and *Kuña Paraguai* broadcasts airing across 13 stations would touch hearts in homes, prisons, and communities, bringing encouragement and transformation.

11 Father, we pray that You would guide the monthly gatherings for women from vulnerable neighbourhoods across Paraguay. Let Your Word and practical workshops bring lasting spiritual growth and sustainable provision for families.

NEW STATIONS, NEW LIFE: RADIO MINISTRY IN SURINAME

TWR Canada continues to play a vital role in expanding radio ministry in Suriname, bringing Christian broadcasting to remote Indigenous communities. Through this partnership, 160 radios have been provided for distribution, and funding supported the final phases of radio tower construction to prepare the stations for launch.

Two new radio stations have been built in the remote villages of Apetina and Tepu, operated by Indigenous believers who serve as elders and community leaders, ensuring the ministry is locally led and culturally rooted. Programming in the Wayana and Trio languages will include biblical teaching, worship, Scripture, and practical community information.

The Apetina and Tepu stations are operational and broadcasts have begun on a limited basis. Programs will begin with morning and evening broadcasts, including worship services for families unable to travel. The stations will also reach distant villages, sharing God's Word with communities that have never heard the gospel. Tom Schoen and Ted Jantz led station operator training, covering sustainable management, equipment operation, solar power systems, emergency procedures, and basic troubleshooting. The communities are excited to celebrate the launch of these stations and a transition to full daily broadcasting with dedication services and further distribution of radios.

Through these efforts, TWR Canada and local partners are establishing a strong, Indigenous-led radio ministry, continuing the legacy of the Schoen family, bringing hope and the message of the gospel to some of Suriname's most remote communities.

WEEK 7 FROM SMALL SEEDS TO STRONG FAITH (SURINAME)

In Suriname, God is using new shortwave radio stations to reach communities isolated from the gospel. With the support of TWR Canada, Indigenous leaders are stepping into this ministry, sharing His Word, worship, and teaching in their own languages. Let us lift up the people, and the broadcasts in prayer, trusting God to bring blessing and transformation. *“That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither — whatever they do prospers.” — Psalm 1:3*

WEEK 8 A DYING TRIBE ENCOUNTERS NEW LIFE (LIFTED)

In connection with our work in Suriname, **TWR Canada is proud to share *Lifted***, a 75-minute documentary that tells the story of **Ivan and Doris Schoen** and the **vibrant Indigenous church continuing their work**. Decades ago, the Schoens brought **the hope of Christ to the Wayana and Trio tribes**, and today **nearly every family follows Jesus**. The film shows how **the gospel took root**, how believers grew in faith, and how **Indigenous leaders now carry Christ's message deeper into the rainforest**. 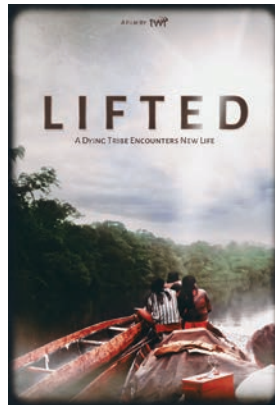
