When I first entered the class, I was terrified; however, as the class went on, I found I was doing very well. I made an A- in nursing chemistry. I learned from this not to prejudge my professor and not to be afraid to ask them for help when I needed it. I realized I shouldn't prejudge and give in to fear.

This scholarship will help me overcome financial obstacles in attending Mount Saint Mary College for the next two years. My sister will be going to college in the fall, and my parents have the tremendous responsibility of sending both their daughters to school. Right now, I am working two jobs to save money for school.
