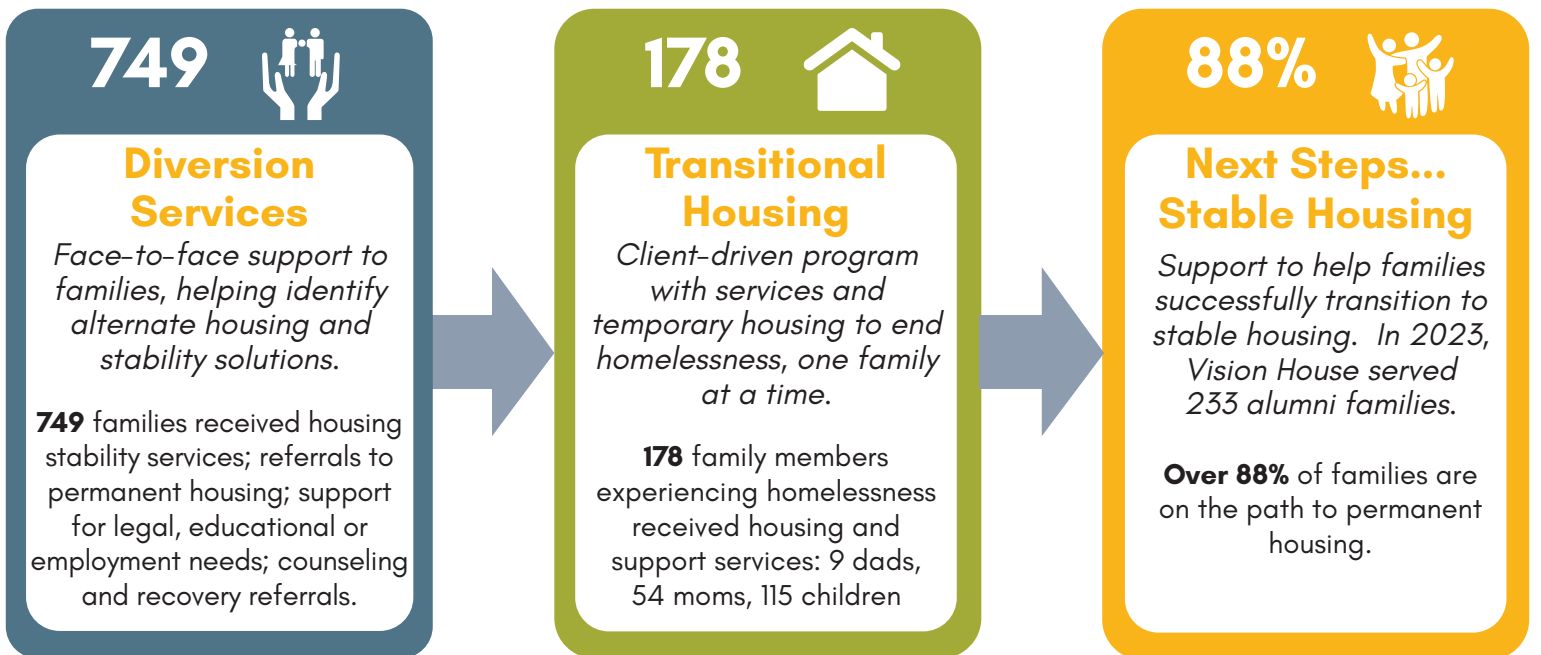
**Our Mission** is to follow Jesus in working with the poor and homeless to promote positive transformation of their lives.

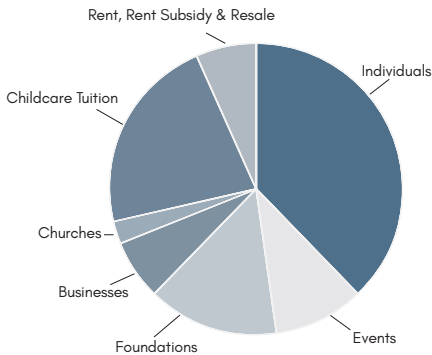

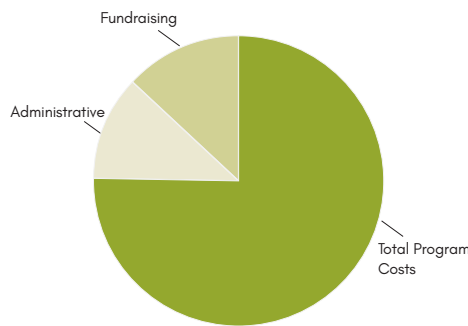

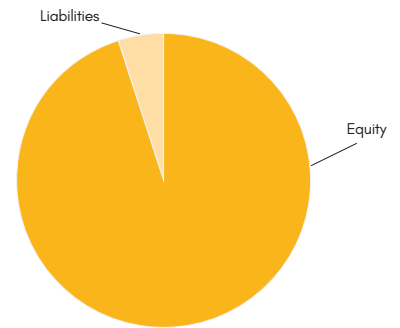
