Look around you. Homelessness is increasing every day. As you know, IHOC has been helping homeless men, women, and children for over 33 years. So, to do its part, IHOC is looking to purchase a property for a Transitional Home for our homeless guests. This is a huge \$1.4 million project with the Mall Walk kicking off our fundraising campaign.

To help cover our initial Project costs, IHOC needs to raise \$70,000 through

## the year's Mall Walk WITH OVER 100 Walkers participating.

The 2024 Mall Walk will be held on Sunday, February 25<sup>th</sup> at the Voorhees Town Center. The fun activities, such as Face and Pet Rocks Painting will start at 1:30 PM with the Walk kicking-off at 2:30 PM.

Walkers will be walking inside the Voorhees Town Center and will be walking the route four times with treats after the laps including a goodie bag after the second lap.

The Scavenger Hunt was a big hit last year and the Mall Walk will again have a Scavenger Hunt with an extra treat at the end of this activity.

At 4:00 PM at the end of the Walk, the Walker and the TEAM which has raised the most will be announced.

Plus, any TEAM which raises over \$2,000 will be treated to a choice of a special dinner at a local restaurant OR trampoline time at Sky Zone.

- The immediate challenge is that right now-- only 8 Walkers have registered. At this time last year, 40 Walkers had registered with 20 online Sponsors.
