## SNAPSHOT OF SERVICES PROVIDED

Fiscal Year 2025: October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2025

The mission of the Family Crisis Center is to be the expert resource and service provider in eliminating domestic and sexual violence in Bastrop, Colorado, Fayette and Lee counties.

- **551** individuals received crisis intervention, advocacy, and support services
- **2,012** hotline calls were answered
- **6,278** nights of emergency shelter provided for **161** adults and **112** children
- **41** adults and **37** children received transitional housing services
- **59** adults and **5** children received counseling services
- **85** adults participated in adult violence intervention programs and **9** participated in parenting education
- **12** adults were provided with Sexual Assault Forensic Examination (SAFE) accompaniment
- **135** individuals were provided with information on the protective order process, **5** temporary orders were granted, and **22** final orders were granted
- **67** violence prevention presentations and/or community activities that reached **1,697** community youth and adults
- **36** volunteers provided **7,372** hours of service

Family Crisis Center has been providing comprehensive services to address and prevent domestic and sexual violence for over 40 years. Services include 24/7 access to hotline, crisis intervention, & emergency shelter services; assistance filing protective orders, assault charges, and crime victim's compensation; safety planning; court and SAFE accompaniment; victim advocacy; counseling; transitional housing; offender accountability programs; and school and community based prevention and education efforts.

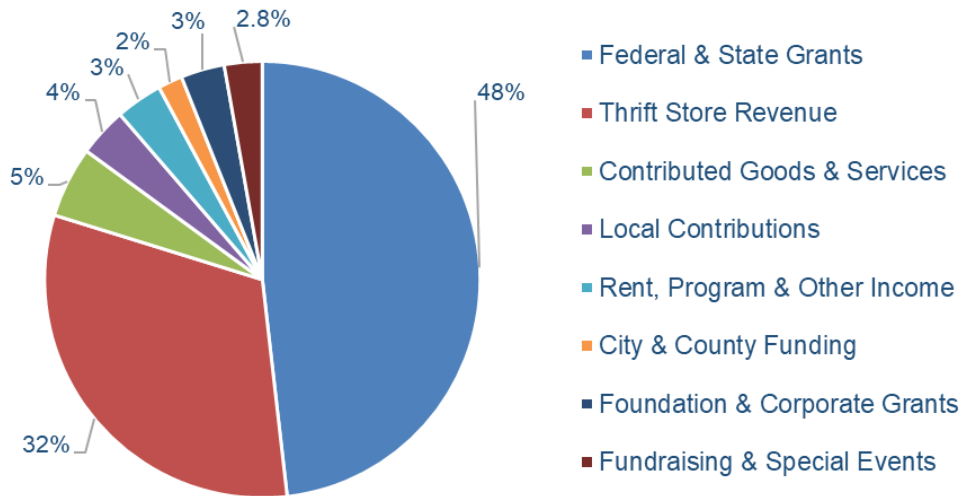
